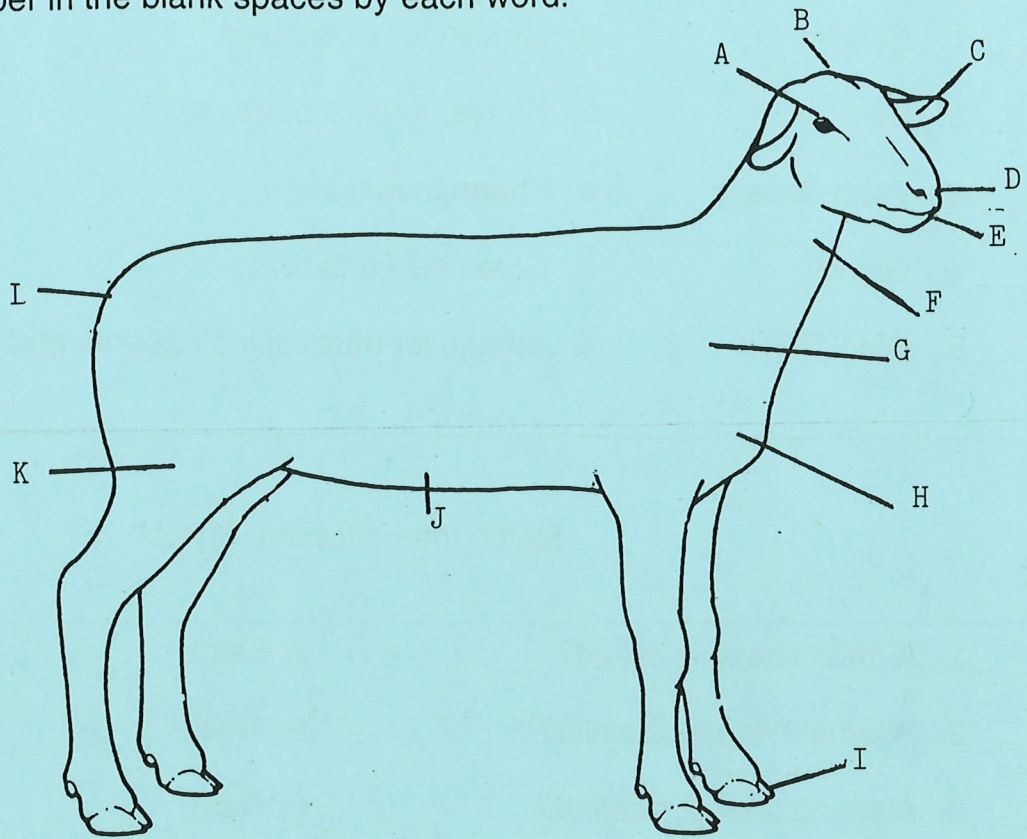
- Bring your completed pages 2 and 3 to the County Fair. Be sure to fill it out completely.
