## New Family Navigator

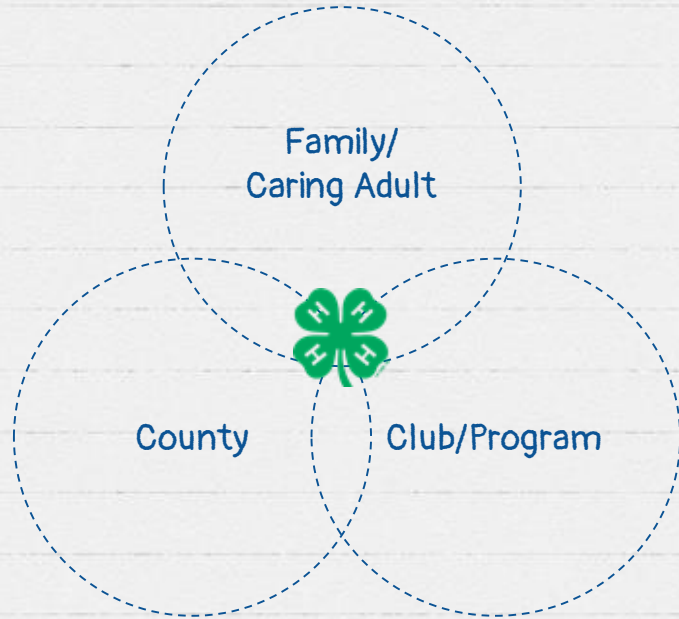
Individuals that ensure that new 4-H members and their families are welcomed, develop a sense of belonging, and have questions answered the first program year.
