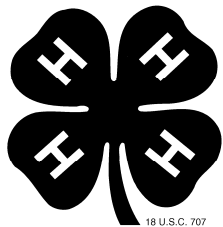

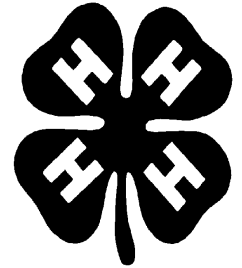

Location: Indiana State Fairgrounds

Date: April 3-5, 2009

Cost: \$? plus stall fee

Who is eligible: 4-H Horse & Pony Members

Description: 4-H events include demonstrations, public speaking, versatility, hippology, horsemanship/showmanship/equitation clinics, horse bowl, groom & clean, proper tack & fitting & horse judging. Some events are limited by space availability. Pre-registration required by March 15.

Description: Traditional 4-H'ers are needed to help with all aspects of the camp for Mini 4-H members.

### **ENTOMOLOGY SCIENCE WORKSHOP**

Location: Purdue University

Date: June 10-12, 2009

Cost: \$160

Who is eligible: Youth in grades 9-12

Description: Learn about insects, research being done at Purdue & sampling campus life

### **PLANT SCIENCE WORKSHOP**

Location: Purdue University

Date: June 10-12, 2009

Cost: \$160

Who is eligible: Youth in grades 9-12

Description: Educational programs & tours within the areas of horticulture & plant science.

### **CITIZENSHIP WASHINGTON FOCUS**

Location: Washington, D.C.

Date: July 4-July 11, 2009

Cost: \$1200

Who is eligible: 4-H'ers must be 9<sup>th</sup> grade & higher

Description: Delegates will take part in workshops on contemporary issues & topics such as international affairs, human relations, government, ecology & conservation, family life & dating, community development, drama & creative expression, economics, agriculture policy, leadership & careers.

### **\* INDIANA'S YOUTH TOUR sponsored by RushShelby Energy**

### **ANIMAL SCIENCE WORKSHOP**

Location: Purdue University

Date: June 10 -12, 2009

Cost: \$160

Who is eligible: 4-H'ers in grades 9-12

Description: offers training & practical experience in animal production & management. Delegates learn about career opportunities as well as tour many of the animal production & research facilities at the University.

May attend in 1 of the following categories: 1) aquatic science, 2) beef, 3) dairy, 4) goat (dairy & goat), 6) horse, 7) poultry, 8) sheep, 8) rabbit, 9) swine, OR 10) vet. science (separate track for large & small animals)

#### **4-H FOOD SCIENCE & NUTRITION WORKSHOP**

Description: Exposes youth to new & emerging trends in the computer science industry.

Who is eligible: 4-H members in grades 9 -12

Description: Delegates have opportunities to study: principles of flight, build rockets & planes, take a ride in a small airplane & to an astronaut by phone as you learn about the principles of flight & career opportunities.

#### **ENGINEERING SCIENCE WORKSHOP**

Location: Purdue (Ag. & Biological Engineering Dept.)

Date: June 10 -12, 2009

Cost: \$160

Who is eligible: Youth in grades 9-12

Description: Learn about how robots operate, what makes a good fuel for internal combustion engines, how computers draw without pencils, & how to select the best vegetable/fruit variety for mechanical harvesting. Introduces youth to careers in various engineering fields.

Who is eligible: Youth in grades 9-12

Description: Hands on activities to introduce students to the complex issues of traveling to and living on Mars based on NASA Research.

Description: Meet other band members from the state. Intensive workshop to learn to play together & perform.

#### **STATE 4-H CHORUS WORKSHOP**

Location: Purdue University

Date: June 20 -24, 2009 (At 4-H Round-Up)

Cost: \$235

Who is eligible: Youth in grades 9-12, selected by application  
(Those entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade may be considered)

Description: Meet other chorus members from the state. Intensive workshop to learn to sing together & perform.

#### **4-H ROUND-UP**

Location: Purdue University

Date: June 22-24, 2009

Cost: \$160

Who is eligible: Youth who have completed grades 7, 8, 9

Description: Introduce 4-H members to a "Big 10" campus & aid in exposing 4-H members to numerous career opportunities. Delegates stay in dormitory housing on campus & are able to tour many of the campus facilities plus plenty of time for socializing at dances or a movie.

#### **STATE 4-H ELECTRIC WORKSHOP**
