- 10. The correct size board...**
- 9. The correct number of pictures...**
- 8. The correct title for your division...**
- 7. Pictures that are in focus (not fuzzy)...**
- 6. Pictures that show imagination...**
- 5. Pictures that are all different...**
- 4. Pictures that are the correct size...**
- 3. The board is displayed horizontally...**
- 2. That all the pictures are numbered...**

# BOARD REQUIREMENTS

For Beginning, Intermediate and Advanced  
Black & White and Color divisions.

1. Board size is to be 22" x 28". The board must be displayed HORIZONTALLY!
2. Ten photographs are required. These may be displayed either vertically or horizontally on the board.
3. The appropriate title must be displayed. Check your hand-book for the title for your division.
4. Your photos must be numbered from "1" to "10."
5. Put your name tag in the lower right corner.
6. Your board must be covered with clear plastic.
7. The board must be stiff enough to stand on the display racks. Light weight poster board alone is not acceptable. Use corrugated board or foam-core board for additional stiffness.

**PLEASE DO NOT USE WOOD OF ANY KIND TO STIFFEN BOARDS!**

## OPTIONS

1. Five word captions may be used, but this is not recommended.
2. You may use any color board you choose. Bright colors are NOT recommended. A neutral color photographic matte board is best.
