This annual award is provided from the Malcolm E. Grass Memorial Fund.

Grass was a law enforcement officer in Hancock County for 22 years, serving as Sheriff for 9 years.

The 4-H members, leaders and the 4-H Ag Association were of very special interest to him. Serving on the Board of Directors of the 4-H Ag Association and his love and dedication to the 4-H program and the Hancock County 4-H Fair will long be remembered.

This award will be presented prior to the Hancock County 4-H Fair Queen pageant.

The basis for selection of the recipients for this award is as follows:

<i>Community Service</i>	<i>40%</i>
<i>Other Activities</i>	<i>20%</i>

Any 4-H member who has just completed their final year of 4-H activity is eligible for consideration.
