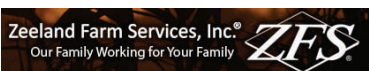
The Purdue Extension Dairy Team, Indiana Professional Dairy Producers (IPDP), and the Indiana Forage Council

Specializing in improving profitability of heifer enterprises, Dr. Leadley consults with individual dairies, lectures, writes the Calf Connection column for Eastern Dairy Business magazine and a monthly newsletter for calf raisers, Calving Ease. ### Dr. Kent Ames

Dr. Ames is a professor in food animal medicine and surgery at Michigan State University. Dr. Ames continues to teach veterinary students, provide veterinary service to the Michigan State University farms and Michigan cattle producers at the MSU Veterinary Teaching Hospital.

### Dr. Allen Bridges

Dr. Bridges joined Purdue in November of 2007 and is the State Extension Specialist in Reproduction. His research program centers around improving reproductive efficiency in livestock by identifying factors that impact reproductive success.
