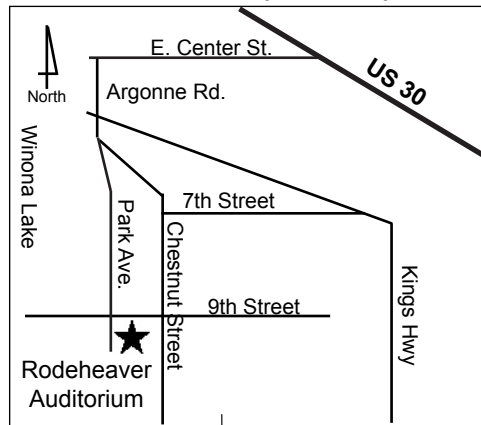

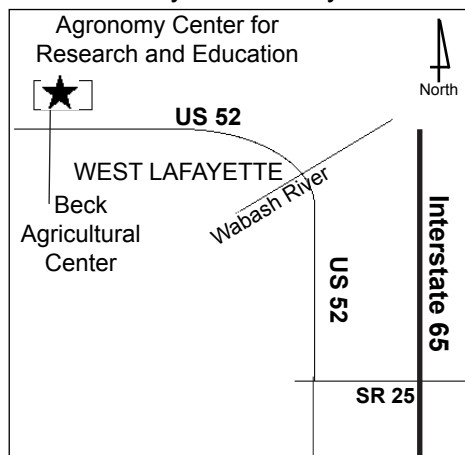

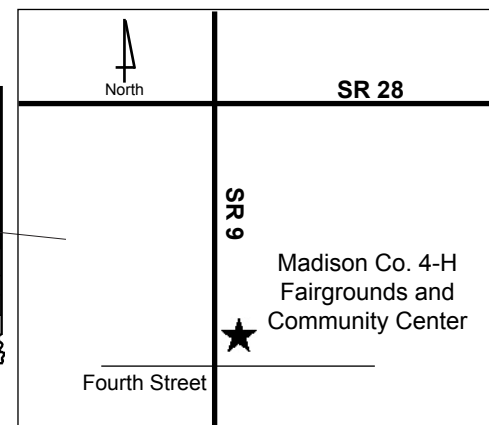
Warsaw - Monday, January 25



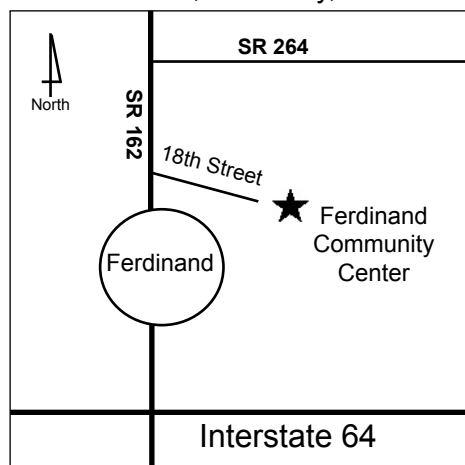
West Lafayette - Friday, Jan. 29



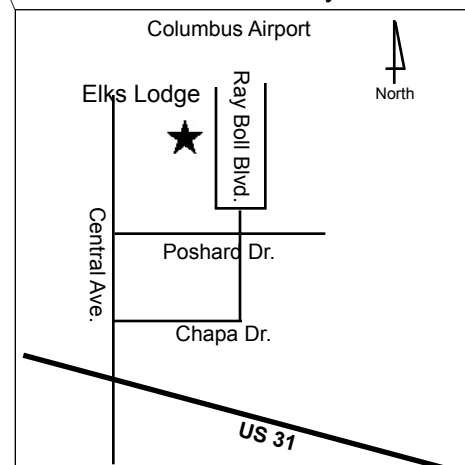

General Information

The Purdue Pest Management Program is offering a series of Crop Management Workshops (CMWs) to be held at five locations throughout Indiana. The topics of these meetings are adapted from the previous cropping year, new technologies, questions asked by agribusiness personnel, and suggestions from past CMWs. Certification credits for Indiana's commercial (CCH) and private (PARP) pesticide applicators and Certified Crop Advisors (CEU) will be awarded to attendees. Credits for Ohio applicators have been requested.

Seating is limited, so register early. Registration is available online with a credit card at <http://www.conf.purdue.edu/crop>; click on the location you want to attend. All efforts will be made to hold these meetings as scheduled. Should it be necessary to cancel this program at a moment's notice (e.g., host county emergency road closures), registered participants will receive a full refund of program fees paid. In the event of such a cancellation, however, Purdue University shall not be responsible for any other expenses incurred by the registrant. A cancelled meeting will not be rescheduled. A full refund is available if notice is provided by phone or in writing prior to January 15, 2010. Other than the above stated reasons, no refunds will be available on or after January 15, 2010.
