- ✓ Thyroid Panel (Free T4, TSH)..... \$65.00
- ✓ Iron (Important for manufacturing of new red blood cells) \$15.00
- ✓ Uric Acid (Gout, kidney malfunction) \$15.00
- ✓ Magnesium (Essential role in balancing body functions) \$15.00
