

Locating Your Census 2000 Data

1. Open your Internet browser, and go to the following web site:
<http://factfinder.census.gov>

2. Click on **Data Sets** in left hand column.

3. For Year 2000 Census Data, click on
Census 2000 Summary File 1 (SF1) 100-Percent Data

4. From the options that appear, click on **Detailed Tables**.

5. Select geographic method to search by (state, county, city, etc.).

Click **Add** to add it to the list.

If you desire, you can choose multiple states, counties, etc.



6. When your geographic location is selected, click on **Next**.
(If you add the wrong location, click on the wrong item and choose Remove)

7. Select the data information you would like to see.

For a good overview of Census 2000 race data, choose:

P7. Race (Total Population)

P11. Hispanic or Latino (Total Population)

PCT11. Hispanic or Latino by Specific Origin

Click on each item you would like to see and click **Add** for each one.

Multiple tables can also be viewed at the same time.

8. Once the data lists you want to view are selected, click **Show Result**.

9. To go back, use the **Back** button in the upper-left corner on your browser.

10. If you would like to print or save the data, use the **Print/Download** button towards the upper-right corner.
