REGISTRATION DUE: April 18 — Make checks payable to Purdue University. Registration fee is \$25.00 per person Any registered contestant who is a no-show must still pay the registration fee. **Blank entries or naming of systems similar to Team Member 1, Team 2, Daffy Duck, Road Runner etc. will NOT be accepted or considered registered. You will be billed for the entry fee, unless you notify the State 4-H Office at least 7 days before the state contest that you team or individual will not be coming to the state contest.**

Lunch Option: **New for 2025** This year's contest will be in conjunction with the State Livestock Judging Contest. We are offering Poultry teams to partake in the lunch if they wish. During registration, please indicate if you want to purchase those extra meal tickets. That will result in an additional \$5/meal ticket. You can also just do lunch on your own as lunch will be served at the conclusion of the contest. We will break for lunch and then return for results. These must be secured at the time of registration.

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

3. All individuals and/or teams are eligible for the state judging contest, but 4-H teams must be approved by the respective county's 4-H Extension Educator.
4. The contest location, registration time and schedule of events are outlined on the enclosed schedule.
