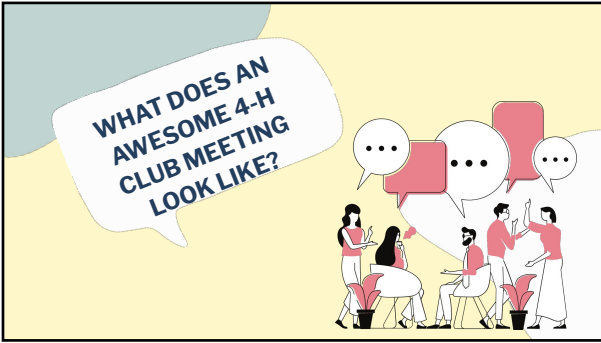

IN-PERSON MEETINGS

Safety Plans

Must have a Safety Plan submitted 3 weeks ahead of meeting/event.
Two versions: Less than 50 or 50+

Keep Your Distance

Be sure to follow local, state, and Purdue guidelines when it comes to health and safety including social distancing, face coverings, communication, and cleaning protocols.

Plan Activities Appropriately

Think about activities that don't involve touching, maybe adjust where your officers sit, and be cautious with passing out materials.
