



Registering as a Judge in 4-H Online

If your family has an existing 4-H Online account but need to add a new family member, login to 4-H Online using the family credentials then skip to page 4, adding a new profile to the family.

If you are a current or past 4-H volunteer with an existing 4-H Online account and profile, login to 4-H Online using the family credentials and skip to page 5, creating a judges profile from an existing volunteer account.


Anyone new to the 4-H Online system begin on page 2.

Users receiving an error message or needing assistance should email in4h@purdue.edu providing tech support the exact error message received or specific information about the issue being experienced.


Creating a New 4-H Online Account

If you already have an account in 4-H Online, you can login to your account and proceed to "4-H Judge Enrollment".


1. Go to <http://v2.4honline.com>.
2. Click "Don't have an account?" if you have never enrolled in 4-H before using 4-H Online.



3. Select Indiana from the drop-down menu.



4. Choose "State Office" as your county from the drop-down menu.



5. Complete your family's information.
6. Click the Create Account button.

1. Select the “Judges” for the Program to join

2. Enter the profile information.
3. Click the Next button.
4. Complete the “About You” form with the requested information.
5. Click the Next button.

NOTE: fields marked with a red asterisk (*) are required fields and must be completed.

6. Select your method of participation.
7. Click the Finish button. Then proceed to “4-H Judge Enrollment”.

1. Login to your 4-H Online family account. Find your name in your Member List
2. Click "Join a Program"

2. Read the “Indiana 4-H Exhibit Judging Consent” and “Operating Procedures for Program With Minors Consent” Agree and sign BOTH at the bottom of each to Accept.

- *Non-animal and animal projects interested in judging.*
- *Judging experience and qualifications, if any.*
- *Concerns about serving as a 4-H judge.*
- *Preferred judging format.*
- *Counties you are available to judge.*
- *The training video outlining judging tips and expectations is required. Subject matter specific training videos are optional.*
