Each local 4-H Youth Development Program is guided by a group of local decision makers who serve on a 4-H Council (or similar group). These decision makers work closely with the County 4-H Youth Development Extension Educator to help the 4-H program achieve the mission of 4-H and the Extension Service.

The 4-H Council Handbook is designed to help those 4-H decision makers contribute to the development of a quality 4-H Youth Development Program in their local communities.
