

## Indiana 4-H Shooting Sports Certification Workshop

The 4-H Shooting Sports program requires certification of volunteers to assure that coordinators and instructors understand the responsibilities in delivering this heightened risk project and are prepared to create a safe and engaging environment.

Each county must have a coordinator and instructors for each discipline to be offered. Coordinators and instructors must also be enrolled and approved as a 4-H Volunteer in 4-H Online. To become certified, individuals must attend an entire 4-H Shooting Sports certification workshop, and pass both a written test and practicum. Note that other certifications and trainings offered by other organizations may <u>not</u> be substituted for the 4-H certification workshop.

4-H Shootings Sports Certification trainings are presented and managed by the Indiana Hunter Educator Association. Trainings are held each spring and fall at Ross Camp in Tippecanoe County.

## **Notes:**

- Checks should be made payable to IHEA Training.
- Full payment must accompany the registration (No reservations without payment.)
- Refund policy is as follows: Full refund until the workshop deadline; one-half the amount from the deadline to 3 full days before the workshop begins; no refunds after that time.
- There will be a \$20.00 late fee assessed for registrations and/or payments received after the due date.
- A minimum number of participants is required in each discipline or the class will be cancelled.

Disciplines offered if an adequate number of participants register:

- Archery
- Muzzleloading
- Pistol
- Rifle
- Shotgun
- Coordinator
- Outdoor Skills (biannually starting fall of 2026)
