- Lots of leaves!
- Paper
- A couple of heavy pebbles
- A smooth, hard surface – like a notebook
- Coloured crayons or pastels

Leaf rubbing



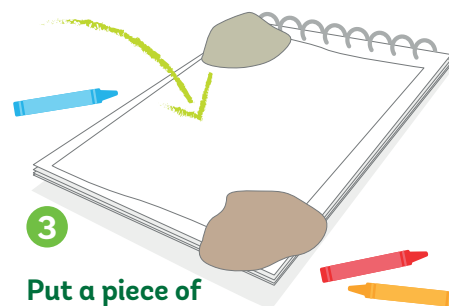

Choose your leaves.
Collect lots of different
shapes, sizes and textures.

Place a leaf onto
a notebook. Make sure the
veins on the bottom of
the leaf are facing upwards.

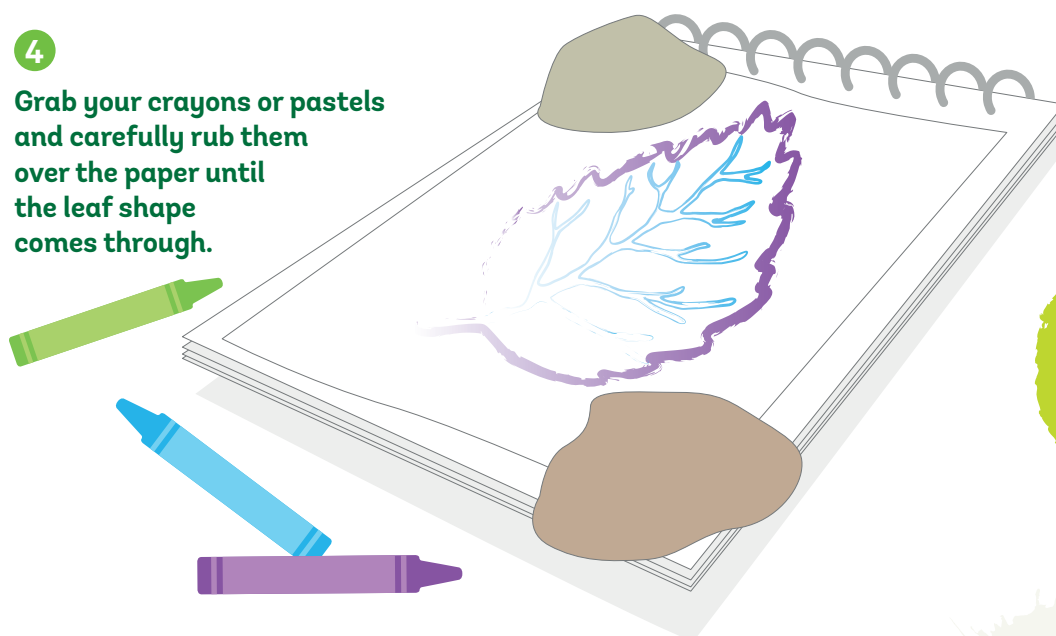

Put a piece of
white paper over
the leaf, and hold it in
place using your pebbles.

Grab your crayons or pastels
and carefully rub them
over the paper until
the leaf shape
comes through.
