- Clover Gaming is for youth in grades 3-12.
- 4-H is all about learning by doing. Clover Gaming will be a hands-on experience for youth.
- The program will cover:
 - **Introduction to Game Mechanics:** Learn the different types of game mechanics (functions of gameplay), and how they are used to drive the game.
 - **Communication, Rules, & Challenges:** Incorporating rules and challenges in gameplay, through effective communication.
 - **Game Narrative & Storytelling:** Develop a narrative through clear communication in storytelling that defines gameplay/game direction.
 - **Strategy:** Learn the nuances of different strategies and how they affect gameplay.

Careers in Gaming: Explore different careers in gaming.

Game Creation, Showcase, and Celebration: Learn how to take all of your ideas, storyboard, design, and code and turn it into a game that others would want to play! Get interactive with others in the program. Play their games, give them feedback, and celebrate everyone's accomplishments!
