



2024 Ag Equipment Diagnostics Contest June 8, 2024

Check-In 8:30-9:00 am, ET; Contest Begins 9:00 am, ET Boone County 4-H Fairgrounds, Lebanon, IN, BCA Building

Contestants must have attended February or March workshop to participate in this contest.

Contestants may compete individually or as a team of two.

Contestants will have 30 minutes to complete a 25 question exam and 60 minutes to identify the electrical system issue and present a written work order based on a given scenario. Exam questions will come from the workshop PowerPoint presentation.

Exam will be worth 100 points and diagnostics is worth 100 points.

Each contestant must provide their own safety glasses, closed toed shoes/boots, and multimeter. No loose-fit clothing or hair is permitted.

Registration fee is \$25.00 per contestant. Payment is due day of contest and will be expected for any no-shows.

All individuals and teams will be assigned an arrival time. The first group will be scheduled to compete at 9:00 am, ET.

Awards will be provided to the top three teams and top three in the individual division.
