Indiana 4-H Youth Development

Youth active in Indiana 4-H report it is a place where they feel safe and learn about ways to help their community. Youth involved in civic engagement report they liked helping people in their community, had met community leaders because of 4-H, encouraged others to volunteer in the community, feel a responsibility to help their community, and were inspired by 4-H to volunteer in their community.



Agriculture & Natural Resources

In “Grow Your Farm Operation”, beginning farmers increased their knowledge of basic estate plans, financial threats from death taxes and nursing home care, farm rental contracts, succession planning, corn yield limiting factors, goals for marketing grain, precision soil mapping, commodity futures, and soil measurements for managing their operations.



Community Development



The Land Use Summit informs professionals, government officials, citizen planners, and residents for building connections to land use planning resources. Purdue Extension examined renewable energy, land-use decision making, and ordinance development strategies adopted by Indiana communities and found concerns from neighbors most frequently influenced changes in regulations of ordinances.

Health & Human Sciences

“Youth Mental Health First Aid” is for adults interested in learning about mental health issues affecting youth. Topics addressed are anxiety, depression, substance use, trauma, and deliberate self-harm. Participants learn to be a resource and provide support for youth at risk. Adults felt confident they could reach out to youth having mental health problems and substance-use challenges or crises.
