

Adams County 4-H Livestock Auction

Thursday, July 24 at 4:00 PM

Livestock Show Arena, 4-H Fairgrounds in Monroe

The 4-H Auction is the culmination of a year of hard work and dedication for more than 250 4-H animal exhibitors in Adams County. Through the livestock projects, 4-H members learn a number of valuable life skills and lessons. This is the final step for their project where they learn important marketing aspects.

How Does The Auction Work?

- Buyer registration can be done day of auction in the Livestock Show Arena beginning at 3PM.
- The Adams County 4-H Livestock Auction is a Premium Auction. (Premium = Per Head not Per Pound)
- **Buyers have the choice** in all species except Poultry, Rabbits and Swine to **keep** the animal or sell it to a packer.
Buyer pays the full bid price, which includes the market value.
- **Buyers have the choice** in all species expect Poultry, Rabbits and Swine to **sell to Packer**:
Buyer does not have to handle or be responsible for animal when it is sold through the auction.
Buyer only pays the difference between the auction price and the market value.
- Dairy Showmanship winners (Junior, Intermediate, & Senior) and Supreme Dairy Champion will sell a plaque and a basket of dairy product with 50% of proceeds going to the 4-H member and 50% to the Dairy Calf Club.
- Horse & Pony Premier Showmanship winner will sell a basket with 50% of proceeds going to the 4-H member and 50% to Horse & Pony Club.
- Buyers can purchase Beef and Starter Calf to donate to a local charity; arrangements must be made ahead of time at local processors.
Buyers wishing to donate Swine to a local charity must reach out to swine members ahead of time to make arrangements for animals and processing.
