

Project Title: Recycling

Description:

Provides an opportunity for youth to learn more about recycling and/or to use their creative talents in designing/making an item to use at home or a piece of artwork from all recycled materials.

State Fair Entries:

No State Fair Exhibit.

Exhibit Guidelines:

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects. One record sheet regardless of number of projects.

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author when using outside sources, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed. Space should be left in the lower right-hand corner to place an exhibit tag provided by Purdue Extension Staff.

Exhibit Class Guidelines:

Categories:

- 1. A 22" x 28" poster on any recycling topic of your choice.
- 2. Artwork or home/household item. Bonding agents or paint do not need to be recycled product.
- 3. Fashion Item

Beginner (grades 3-5)

Each member may enter up to three (3) different project exhibits from the categories above *Intermediate* (grades 6-8)

Each member may enter up to three (3) different project exhibits from the categories above *Advanced (grades 9-12)*

Each member may enter up to three (3) different project exhibits from the categories above
