

Project Title: Sports

Description:

This project allows youth to explore their interests in a variety of different sports. They may research information on a sport of interest to them or report on one they are familiar with.

State Fair Entries:

No State Fair Exhibit.

Exhibit Guidelines:

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects. One record sheet regardless of number of projects.

All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author when using outside sources, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

Exhibit Class Guidelines:

Beginner (grades 3-5)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about a sports topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate. You may submit a maximum of three (3) exhibits.

Intermediate (grades 6-8)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about a sports topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate. You may submit a maximum of three (3) exhibits.

Advanced (grades 9-12)

Create an educational poster, notebook or display about a sports topic of choice that is age/grade appropriate. You may submit a maximum of three (3) exhibits.
