

# Camping at Fair

As you start to plan for an exciting fair week, we will be following the same protocol for camping this year. During fair week, we require ANYONE bringing a camper/RV/trailer with living quarters to pre-register and pay for the days that the indicated vehicle will be at the fair, even if not plugging into electrical. All campers/RV/Trailers must fit in and park in the spot designated by the committee.

Campsites/electrical hook ups will be assigned on a a <u>first come, first serve basis</u> by the Committee. The Committee will make every effort to accommodate all requests, however please be aware that submitting a form and payment does not guarantee you a site. Last year space filled up quickly so plan to return your form as soon as possible for the best chance of securing a site. As a reminder, overnight camping is strictly prohibited during the Boone County 4-H Fair.




