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- 1. It is the responsibility of each Commercial Exhibitor (*Business/Organization*) to provide liability insurance for your booth and workers. The "Proof of Insurance" is <u>MANDATORY</u> per Indiana Department of Health.
- 2. It is agreed that the exhibitor will conduct their exhibits so as not to interfere with other exhibitors, and so that all exhibitors may enjoy the full rights and privileges of their space.
- 3. The Brown County 4-H Fair Board cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to any unmanned booth.
- 4. The Brown County 4-H Fair Board reserves the right to cancel any Commercial Exhibitor agreement, if it deems necessary and is in the best interest of the fair to do so.
- 5. All both spaces are to be manned during hours listed below. See Booths Open
- 6. All set up materials, i.e., extension cords, fire extinguishers, tables, fans, canopies, etc. are the responsibilities of the exhibitor. There are no exterior/interior walls on the majority of the Commercial Building.
- 7. Duct tape or any type of adhesive product may **<u>NOT</u>** be used on the building floor or walls.
- 8. All trash & supplies used in your exhibit must be disposed of correctly and daily.
- 9. Food booths **MUST** supply a menu when they submit their application and payment.
 - a. Menus will be <u>pre-approved</u> by The Brown County 4-H Fair Board. There may be items that you will be asked to remove from options offered.
 - b. Food booths **MUST** clean-up and properly dispose of grease and cooking oil.
 - c. Food booths are required to supply their own fully charged and up to date fire extinguishers.
 - d. All gas, LP, diesel or combustible fuel tanks **MUST** be secure outside of buildings.
- 10.All pressurized tanks **MUST** be securely tied down to avoid any accidents.
- 11.NO PETS allowed on the fairgrounds without prior approval from The Brown County 4-H Fair Board. This will be closely monitored. **Only 4-H Animals are to be on the fairgrounds**
- 12.NO RV's on the fairgrounds including exhibitors for overnight stay.

Set-Up: Sunday, June 8th from 12-4pm

Your space will be marked in chalk on concrete floor (a chart of the spaces will be posted in the commercial area for reference in locating your assigned space).

Booths Open: Monday, June 9th – Saturday, June 14th from 6pm to 10pm.

<u>Tear Down</u>: Sunday, June 15th (all materials MUST be off fairgrounds by no later than 10pm) Please keep this document as a reference to the Contract Agreement in which you as a Commercial Exhibitor (Business/Organization) has entered into with the upcoming Brown County 4-H Fair.
