Fair Entry Dates

FairEntry will open June 1st~! All members need to have all their projects selected and entered by June 15th in order to exhibit/show at the fair. It is recommended to note these dates and submit projects before the final deadline.

4-H Books

At this time, if you have not yet picked up your project books, please stop by the office to do so. There is no need to call ahead this year.

QLC/YQCA

If you did not attend a Decatur County QLC training, it is expected that you complete the online YQCA training or an QLC training in another county. Upon completion, a copy of the QLC/YQCA certificate must be provided to the office. It is expected to have this completed by June 15th. If this is not completed you will not be eligible to show at the fair.

Static Project Check-In

To quickly explain to any family that may be new to the 4-H Program or potentially someone that needs a refresher to static project check-in. When you arrive to the Fairgrounds for project check-in you will go to the Community Building (New Building) for that time. When you arrive at the building you will be directed by a 4-H Volunteer which table to take your applicable project (i.e., cake decorating to the cake decorating table). Depending on the number of individuals checking-in simultaneously you may have to wait in line. Once you reach the table, your project will be checked-in by a fellow 4-Her or volunteer. The project is then immediately judged by the onsite judge. The judge will notify you of your placing as a first, second, or third place.

Once all projects are judged it will then be the hard decision of the judge to select the class, division, and overall champion/res champion & grand/reserve grand champions. Youth will not learn of the overall rankings until the buildings are open to the public.

Grounds Fee Information

Grounds fee forms were due on June 1st. If you have not submitted this form and payment, you are not guaranteed a pen/stall or specific placement. You can still submit this form and payment to the office.

Please note that if you did not submit a t-shirt size on the grounds fee form, you will not receive a t-shirt this year.
