

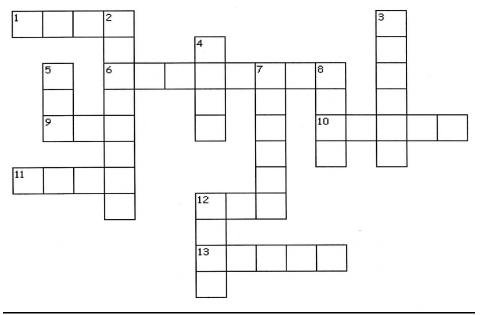

- 6. The upper Joint of the foreleg, including the section of the body from the neck back through the last rib.
- 9. Part of the body used for hearing.
- 10. The abdomen, from the last rib to the pelvis, containing primarily the digestive organs.
- 11. The hair coasts of the English Angora, French Angora, Jersey Wooly and American Fuzzy Lop.
- 12. The joint of the hindquarters that attaches the hind legs to the trunk of the body.
- 13. The front part of the body between the neck and forelegs.

- 3. The lower portion of the face, nose, mouth, and lower jaw of a rabbit.
- 4. The rounded, upper portion of the hindquarters.
- 5. Part of the body used for seeing.

- 8. The curved bones of the rabbit that are immediately behind and under the shoulders and above the belly.
