IMPORTANT: Livestock News Beef Weigh-In February 22nd from 9-10am at Fairgrounds.

- (Weigh-in is ONLY for Rate of Gain. This is NOT MANDATORY.
- The calf must be led onto the scale and back onto the trailer.
- Cattle tags will be sold during weigh-in but **NO** tagging will take place during weigh-in.
- All tagging must be completed by May 15th. Tagging is to be done on your own, you must send a video of your cattle being tagged to Adrienne Fisher at (317-512-1853) by the May 15th deadline. If a leader is present for tagging a video is not required to be sent. Please reach out to Ashton Licht if you need assistance with tagging your animal.
- Taggers are available in the Extension Office for use if needed.

Sheep/Goat Tagging & Weigh-In April 25th from 6-8pm at the Fairgrounds Poultry show start time will be 9:00 am Friday July 11th. Beef show start time 9am Saturday July 12th Swine show start time 8 am Monday July 14th Rabbit show will be Monday July 14th 6pm (check in 5-6pm).
