## **Quality Livestock Care (QLC) for Livestock Exhibitors**

All 4-H youth exhibiting: Beef, Dairy Feeder, Dairy, Lamb, Swine, Goat, Poultry and Rabbits will need to complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program or Youth for Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) program. This program will allow the youth to learn more about:

- · Their role in food animal production
- Food Safety
- Animal Care
- How to use the life skills members learn from their projects.

The Indiana 4-H QLC program will only be offered in person and is \$3.00 payable at the door during the class. You will need to preregister for the classes in 4-H Online: https://QLC20242025.4honline.com

Indiana 4-H will recognize the YQCA program this year as we transition, but this will only be offered online at: <a href="https://yqcaprogram.org">https://yqcaprogram.org</a> The online version is \$12.00. If you chose to complete the online version, you must email or drop off a copy of the certificate to the Extension office.
