WHAT IS FAIR ENTRY?



FairEntry works in cooperation with 4-H Online, so you will use the same username and password.



Families will use this data management system to pre-enter specific projects for the fair. FairEntry will be used to create project labels, check in sheets, judging sheets, show programs, media reports, ribbon placings, award placings and more.



For projects divided by grade level you will use the grade you were in as of January 1st.

Pay attention to the information in this FairEntry Guide as it will make your registration process as smooth and easy as possible!

FAIR ENTRY REGISTRATION STEPS

- 1.Go to the 2025 Harrison County 4-H Fair: https://fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/21881
- Recommended browsers: Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox. Older versions of Internet Explorer may cause unexpected results.
- Register all entries for each exhibitor in the family before proceeding to the Payment section.
- Be sure to click "submit" when you have completed your entries. Entries are not final until they have been submitted.



- 2. Select the "Sign in with your 4-H Online" option
- the GREEN box
- 3. A separate box will pop up where you can enter the login email address and password from 4HOnline.
- (If you don't remember your password, you will need to select the "I forgot my password" option to get a temporary one emailed to you. If your email address has changed, log in using the old email address and change it in 4-H Online.)
- 4. Click the "Sign in" box.

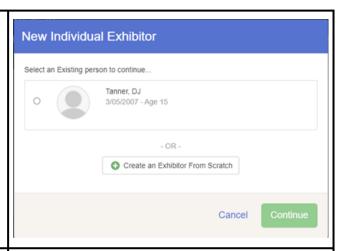

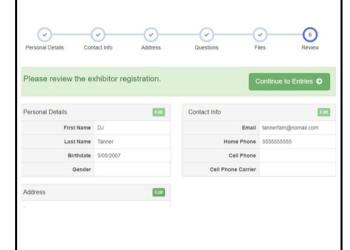
- 6. Choose the register an exhibitor button and click the green "Individual" box.

- Please do not create any exhibitors from scratch, as you will not be able to add exhibits for the projects you are enrolled in.



- 8. Answer any requiredquestions and reviewthe exhibitor registration information.
- 9. Make any necessary corrections (using the edit boxes). Remember that any corrections made here DO NOT transfer back to your 4HOnline Account
- 10. If Additional questions are requiredby your county, complete the questions and then select the green "Continue" box
- When you are taken back to the Exhibitor information page, click the green "Continue to Entries" button

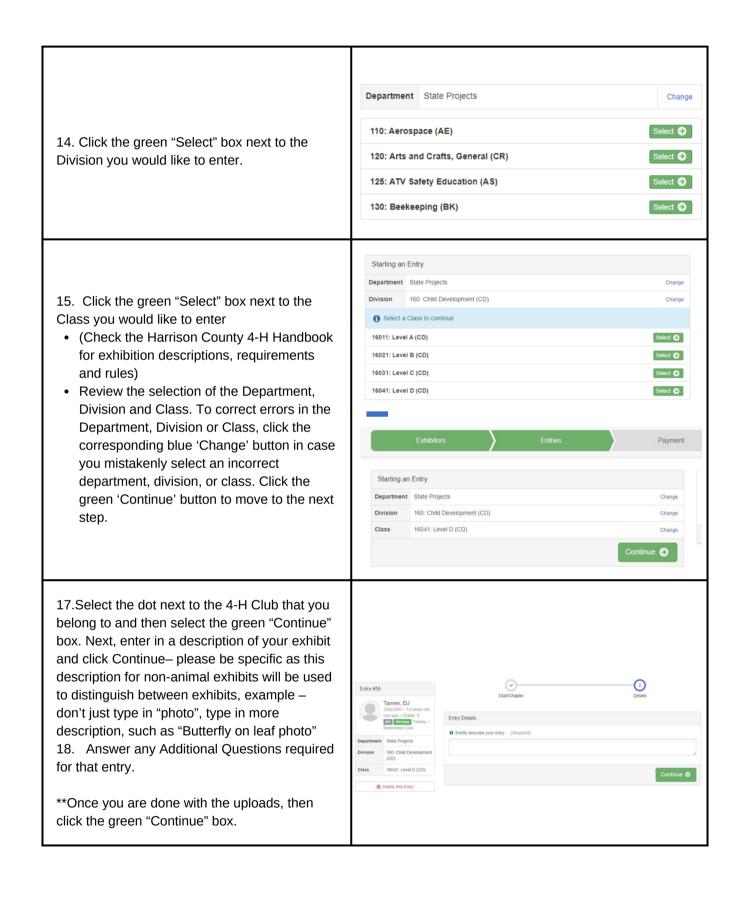

13. Click the green "Select" box next to the Department you would like to enter. Any departments that are not available for entry will be noted as "Not Available" with a short explanation.

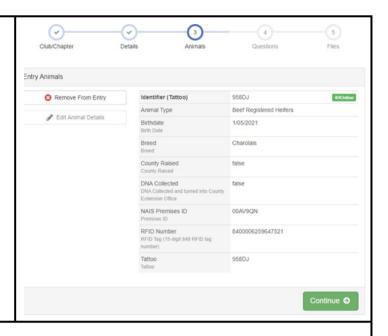

SECTION 4- PAYMENT TAB

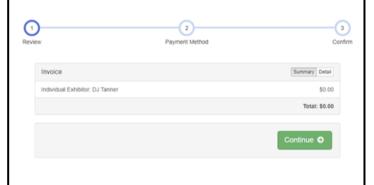
***The payment section is a formality of the system. No payment is needed, but you must go through the steps to submit your entries. It is best to enter all entries for all exhibitors in your family before completing the Payment and submission steps.

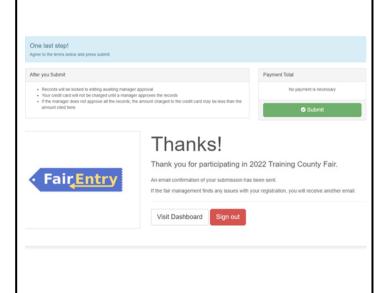
- 26. Review your invoice, in either summary format or detail format. If it looks correct, click the green "Continue" box. If not, go back to the entries tab and fix what you need to.
- 27. Select the green "Continue" box.
- 28. Continue to confirmand submit your entries. NOTE: Once you hit submit, you cannot edit your entries.

29.Click the Submit button to submit your entries. 30.You will receive a "Thanks!" message. You can choose the button to "Visit Dashboard" to see your entry.

You will receive an email from FairEntry after your entry has been submitted.

You will also receive an email from FairEntry letting you know if your entry was approved or rejected by the County Extension Staff. If part of your entry was rejected, a reason will be listed and you will be able to log in and fix the problem before submitting that entry again. Please contact the Harrison County Extension Office if you have any problems with this process at 812-738-4236.





4-H ONLINE PROJECTS V.S. FAIR ENTRY ENTRIES

In 4-H Online, your 4-H'er chooses project categories that they may want to partake in for the 4-H Fair. When it comes time to enter projects into FairEntry, you use the project categories your 4-H'er chose in 4-H Online but then you get more specific about your project.
