The Golden Clovers 4-H Club meets once a month in Palmyra in the basement of the Palmyra Church of Christ (the church building is next to and on the same side of the street as Sav-A-Step). Parking is available on the side and at the rear of the building – enter at the rear of the building. The meetings through December are on Monday's normally at 6:30 PM: October 7th; November 4th; and December 2nd. Meetings last about an hour; parents can stay for the meeting or leave and return later to pick up their youth.
