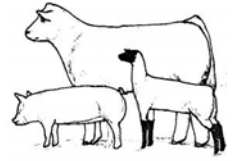


Hampton Memorial

- Leadership roles

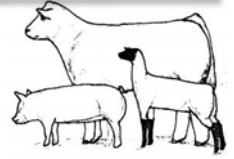
