
The Hendricks County Pork Producers Association will offer one or more scholarship(s) of \$500.00 (or more) to a qualified Hendricks County student to help further his/her educational goals and to recognize his/her involvement in the swine industry. This scholarship will be non-renewable.

## Criteria for Consideration

- 1. Must be a Hendricks County resident.
- 2. Recipient must have been involved in the swine industry for at least four (4) years. Applicable experience might include: 4-H Swine project, junior exhibitions, employment at a swine facility, or involvement in a family swine production facility.
- 3. Applications will be entertained/accepted from 2026 high school graduates.
- 4. Candidates will be evaluated, and scholarships awarded on the following basis:
  - a) Activities in the swine industry
  - b) Involvement in junior swine activities, 4-H, and FFA
  - c) Community activities and involvement
  - d) Academic achievement
  - e) Future goals/plans
- 5. Candidates may be required to complete an interview before final selection.
- 6. Scholarship recipients must be accepted to or currently enrolled in a college, junior college, or trade school.

## Awarding of Scholarships

- 1. Scholarship winners will be announced and recognized at his/her high school awards program and at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair.
- 2. Recipient must provide acceptance letter or provide proof of current enrollment in college, junior college, or trade school to receive scholarship award.
- 3. The Hendricks County Pork Producers will pay the scholarship award directly to the student. The awarded scholarship amount may be applied to tuition, fees, or housing.
