Dear Crafter:

The Hendricks County Extension Homemakers will sponsor Holiday Fest 2026 on **Friday, December 4, 2026**, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Holiday Fest will be held at the Hendricks County 4-H Fairgrounds & Conference Complex, 1900 E Main Street, Danville, IN. The trade show and cookie walk will again be located in the Hendricks Power Expo Hall!

We invite you to reserve a booth for this fun and exciting day. Enclosed you will find a craft booth registration form. Here are a few important details regarding booths:

- No cookies may be sold from your booth, as the Homemakers Fundraiser during Holiday Fest includes a Cookie Walk.
- Booths will be 10' wide x 8' deep.
- Rental fees are:
 - \$40.00 per booth for non-Hendricks County Extension Homemakers.
 - \$30.00 per booth for non-profit organizations, with proof of non-profit status required for the discount.
 - \$20.00 for **one** 10'x8' booth for Hendricks County Extension Homemaker members or clubs, as long as a HCEH member is present and running the booth. HCEH members and Clubs are limited to **one** 10'x8' booth at the discounted rate of \$20. Additional booths are available at the regular rate of \$40.
- Each booth will be furnished with one chair.
 - One table and chair are provided per booth. If you do not need the table, please indicate that on the registration form.
 - Additional Tables are available for \$10.00 and must be pre-ordered.
 - You may bring your own additional small tables, display racks or chairs, to fit in the 10' wide x 8' deep space.
- You are expected to stay in your allotted space and not overlap into another vendor space or the aisles.
- Booths **MUST** remain intact until 3:00 p.m. Any vendor that leaves prior to 3:00 p.m. will not be permitted to return in 2027.
- Electrical outlets are very limited and are available on a first-come-first-served basis.

Returning exhibitors have until September 15th to request their 2026 location. After September 15th all applications will be assigned space on a first-come, first-served basis. Our best effort will be made to accommodate requests to be located next to another vendor and not to place vendors with competing products next to each other. Keep in mind, the longer you wait to submit an application, the less likely it is we can separate like vendors.

An application is enclosed for your convenience.
