Dear 4-H Goat Member:

It's that time of year again! The 2025 Howard County 4-H Fair is just a few months away. To exhibit your animal at the fair, please ensure that you meet the following requirements:

- Identify animals in 4-H Online by May 15 at <u>https://v2.4honline.com/</u>.
 - Siblings may co-enroll goats, but the animals must be listed separately on each 4-H member's goat identification in 4-H online.
- Register animals in Fair Entry from May 17 through June 15 at https://fairentry.com/.
- Complete QLC (Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care) training by June 1. Information regarding this training is enclosed.

Goat check-in is Sunday, July 6, from 7:30 to 9:00 PM. The Howard County 4-H Goat Show is on Monday, July 7, 2024, at 1:00 PM.

Health papers are no longer required to exhibit animals at the Howard County 4-H Fair. However, the superintendent will inspect every animal, and any animal considered unhealthy or contagious WILL NOT be allowed to unload.

STATE FAIR

DNA envelopes are required and due by May 15 in the Extension Office if you plan to exhibit your animal at the Indiana State Fair. Visit <u>https://www.indianastatefair.com/p/state-fair/competitions--contests/4-h-competitions-entry-information</u> for more information.
