










What is Purdue Day of Giving?

All 4-H members planning to exhibit livestock at the 2025 Jasper County Fair are required to complete an in-person Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care training (\$3, sign up in 4HOnline) OR an online YQCA training (\$12, sign up at yqcaprogram.org). You \ only need to complete one or the other. YQCA certificates must be emailed newman84@purdue.edu prior to June 30th to ensure completion.

Jasper County 4-H Council Project Pool Funding Guidelines



The Jasper County 4-H Council is committed to providing real-life educational opportunities that develop young people in Jasper County to positively impact their community and world. The 4-H Council has ear marked funds in their annual budget to assist 4-H clubs, members and programs throughout the year.

Project pool funds are available to 4-H clubs, projects, special interest clubs, and 4-H programs that are included in the Jasper County 4-H program.

4-H volunteers or youth may submit an application anytime throughout the program year as long as funds are still available. The 4-H adult volunteer/ youth must provide an overview of how the grant directly benefits every 4-Her for this year and/or years to come.

Applications can be submitted to 4-H Youth Development Educator, Peyton Newman, at the Jasper County Extension Office or via email at newman84@purdue.edu. The Jasper County 4-H Council will review applications to ensure guidelines have been met. The committee will then select applicants for approval at the next 4-H Council meeting.

Recipients will be notified with a letter of approval in their email. Denials are not subject to an appeal. However, applicants are encouraged to reapply in the future.

In the past, project pool funds have been used to assist with costs of the Jasper County 4-H Horse and Pony Camp and revamping the 4-H Junior Leader Pop Stand. Other examples of fund use could include club trips, camps, awards, community service projects, etc.
