Available scholarships include: 4-H Accomplishment Scholarships (many categories, open to grades 10-12 & one year post high school), 4-H Club Scholarship (open to high school seniors planning to attend Purdue University in the fall, majoring in the College of Agriculture or select majors in the College of Health and Human Sciences), 4-H Senior Year Scholarship (open to high school seniors), and Laurenz Greene Memorial Excellence in 4-H


