Students and educators of all backgrounds and expertise are encouraged to participate and ignite a new spirit of innovation as we celebrate 250 years of independence and look forward to the next 250 years.

There are three tracks. Each group will contain 1-4 members and must have a mentor. Each adult mentor must be an approved 4-H volunteer. 


