

CONTESTANT 4-H ROYALTY CONTEST INFORMATION

CONTEST ELIGIBILITY

- ♦ All females and males currently enrolled in at least their 8th, 9th, or 10th year of 4-H in Kosciusko County or members in their last 3 years of 4-H eligibility (Grades 10, 11, or 12)
- ♦ All 4-H members not previously selected as the Kosciusko County 4-H King or 4-H Queen are eligible to apply

ADDITIONAL CONTEST INFORMATION

- ♦ Escorts for the 4-H Queen Contestants will be 4-H King Contestants or 4-H Junior Leaders
- ♦ Approach the interview portion of the contest as if you were applying for employment with a business. Dress for success.
 - Prior to the interviews, introduce yourself and tell your current year in 4-H and how many years are left in your 4-H career

4-H KING, QUEEN, PRINCE, & PRINCESS DUTIES

- ♦ Assist & demonstrate activities for the Battle of the Barns
- ♦ Fair Parade participation is encouraged. Details will be provided as they are known.
 - The 4-H King & 4-H Queen may be in one conveyance, or all four members of the Court may participate in the same conveyance.
 - Members of the Royalty Court are responsible to find a conveyance, a driver, & an appropriate sign to recognize the Court
 - Conveyance may be a car, truck, or decorated float
 - A script will be provided
- ♦ Represent Kosciusko County 4-H at 4-H and related events during Fair Week
 - Consideration is given to individual 4-H schedules & responsibilities
Examples: Ribbon Cutting, 4-H Livestock judging events, and/or any other 4-H promotional event as designated by the Committee
- ♦ Tell your 4-H story and promote 4-H through a radio interview
- ♦ Participate in Sale of Champions:
 - Lead the 4-H Pledge & Pledge of Allegiance
 - Fundraise by organizing a buyer group, or an individual, to purchase the sale of your 'Kiss' during the Sale of Champion. Determine the area of 4-H to receive the funds.
- ♦ Serve as positive told models for younger 4-Hers
- ♦ If at all possible, the 4-H King & 4-H Queen will return the following year at Public Fashion Revue to crown the next members of the 4-H Royalty Court
