Exhibits can be a poster (22" x 28") following general poster requirements, or notebook. Topics cannot meet exhibit requirements for any other project.

Level 1 Grades 3-5:

Create a poster or notebook about any historical places within Indiana. Examples: Connor Prairie Village, Old Fort in Fort Wayne, homesteads.

Level 2 Grades 6-8:

Create a poster or notebook about any person from Indiana that is famous or a person who made an impact within society. Examples: Michael Jackson, Larry Bird, or Lyndon B. Johnson.

Level 3 Grades 9-12:

Create a poster or notebook about any historical events that happened in Indiana. Examples: How/when Indiana became an official state, the Indiana Gas Boom, or efforts to help during WWII.
