<u>Level A Grades 3-4</u>: Read at least 2 books, short stories, magazines, or poems. One must be from the Indiana Recommended Reading list within or above your grade level. Fill out the reading log available at the Extension Office. Choose one of the following:

- Design a book cover for one of the books you read.
- Make a poster about one of the books you read.
- Make a flyer encouraging people to read.
- Make a shoe box diorama of a scene from one of the books you read.

<u>Level B Grades 5-6</u>: Read at least 3 books, short stories, magazines, or poems. One must be from the Indiana Recommended Reading List within or above your grade level. Fill out the reading log available at the Extension Office. Choose one of the following:

- Design a book cover for one of the books you read.
- Make a poster about one of the books you read.
- Interview a character. Write a least 10 questions that will give the character his/her thoughts and feelings about their role in the story. Answer the questions about how you think the character would respond.
- Make a timeline for the works of an author.

<u>Level C Grades 7-9</u>: Read at least 4 books, short stories, magazines, or poems. One must be from the Indiana Recommended Reading List within or above your grade level. Fill out the reading log available at the Extension Office. Choose one of the following:

- Design a book cover for one of the books you read.
- Make a poster about one of the books you read.
- Write a different ending for one of the books you read.
- Create a timeline about major events from one of the books you read.

<u>Level D Grades 10-12</u>: Read at least 5 books, short stories, magazines, or poems. One must be from the Indiana Recommended Reading List within or above your grade level. Fill out the reading log available at the Extension Office. Choose one of the following:

- Design a book cover for one of the books you read.
- Make a poster about one of the books you read.
- Create a 3–4-page newsletter for your book. Newsletter must include articles on the plot, 1-2 characters, editorial review, and a collection of ads pertaining to the story.
- Write a book review as if it would be for a newspaper or an online venue. Be sure to read a few different book reviews so you know how it should be done.
