Don't Panic: QLC & YQCA Are Both A-OK!

We've heard the whispers...

"Do I need QLC or YQCA?" "Which one is the right one?" "What if I did the wrong one?"

Here's the deal: **both QLC and YQCA are accepted** for participation at the **County and State Fair**. So if you've completed **either one**, you're good to go!

No need to double up or stress—just make sure it's on your record and you're all set.

It's FairEntry Time!

FairEntry is the online platform we use to register all 4-H projects and animals for the Kosciusko County 4-H Fair. Your entries help us create show programs, print exhibitor cards, track results, and keep things running smoothly during fair week.

Deadline for General Projects & Livestock: June 15

Because it falls on a weekend, our office will not be available for last-minute help. If you wait until late Saturday or Sunday to submit and run into a problem, there may not be anyone to assist you in time.

We strongly encourage you to complete your entries early!

That way, if any questions or issues come up, we'll have time to help you before the deadline.

Let's help make this a smooth and stress-free process — for you and for us!

NEW THIS YEAR – Mini 4-H Members Must Use FairEntry!

That's right—Mini 4-H families now need to complete FairEntry, too! It's part of our regular fair prep process moving forward.

To enter Mini 4-H projects:

- 1. Click "County Only Projects"
- 2. Select "Mini 4-H"
- 3. Choose your project(s)
- 4. Click **Submit**

Simple, quick, and gets your Mini ready for the fair fun!

Before You Hit Submit...

Please double-check your entries before submitting!

Once you submit, you **won't** be able to add new exhibitors or exhibits until we've reviewed and approved your original submission. Submitting too early is one of the most common issues we see—and it can cause delays.

Wristbands & Hang Tags

What You Need to Know

Wristband pick-up for **4-H members** and **enrolled volunteers** begins **Monday, June 16** at the Kosciusko County Fair Office (next to the grandstands).

Parents who are *not* registered volunteers may purchase wristbands for **\$20 each** at that time.

Final pick-up deadline:

Monday, July 7 at 7:59 PM — No exceptions. No extensions.

Hang Tags:

Each family will receive a maximum of 2.

No vehicle will be allowed through the East Gate without one properly displayed.

Volunteer Enrollment = Free Wristband

To receive a free wristband as a volunteer:

- *You must be fully enrolled in 4HOnline by June 15
- * Only names on the official submitted list will receive wristbands
- * No late additions after the list is turned in
- * Starting in 2026, the deadline moves to March 15

Reminder⁻

Wristbands are required at the **West Gate**, and everyone in your vehicle must be wearing one for **East Gate** entry.

The **Record of Achievement** isn't just a form—it's your personal highlight reel of everything you've accomplished in 4-H this year!

Think of it as your chance to show off your hard work, leadership, and growth—plus, it comes in handy for some big opportunities:

Scholarships – Many applications ask for info that's already in your record.

Royalty Contest – Judges look at these!

Senior Awards - Including "Most Points Earned by a Senior."

You can pick up a copy during fair week at the 4-H Fair Office or download it anytime from our website.

Deadline to turn it in: Monday, July 14, 2025

Return it during the fair or drop it off at the Extension Office—just make sure it's in on time!

Poster Project Must-Knows!

Bringing a poster project to the fair? Make sure you follow the guidelines below to avoid point deductions or lower grades. Let's set you up for success!

Poster Checklist:

Size: Posters must be **22" x 28"** unless your project manual says otherwise. (And no, they don't have to be white!)

Labels:

You'll get a 3" x 5.5" label at project check-in from the 4-H Office. It goes in the **bottom right corner**—plan your layout accordingly!

Backing:

Posters must be mounted to prevent curling. Use one of these:

Foam core board

- Very stiff cardboard
- Plywood or Masonite (at least 1/8" thick)

No flimsy paper or rolled edges, please!

Plastic Covering:

Cover your poster with a **clear plastic sleeve** to protect it. These are available at the Extension Office for just **\$0.25**. **Please don't use kitchen wrap—it doesn't hold up!**

Citations:

Educational posters must cite all sources used—just like school projects!

Club Info

Write your name and 4-H club clearly on the back of your poster.

Orientation:

All posters should be displayed **horizontally**—think dollar bill layout!






