






4-H Al Workshop – Fawaaz Shareef – Sunday, March 16, Extension Office – 2 pm



The Tello drone/UAV is no longer being produced; however, it is still generally available through a number of on-line vendors. Due to what promised to be availability challenges, the competition will start to phase out the Tello over the next few years. Thus, this year, we will have a number of Tellos available at the competition along with at least one "CoDrone" UAV/drone. Thus, both drones will be used at the competition, based on the preference of the pilot.


