June 13th | All Livestock entered in Fair Entry (these are the specific animals you will be bringing to fair)

Member Enrollment

• All members must be enrolled in 4HOnline. You are not an active 4-H member until the \$15 State Program Fee is paid and approved.

Animal ID Requirements

- ID Days will be held on:
 - Friday, February 21st By appointment only, families will need to call or text Jeff Smoker at 219-280-0524 by February 15, 2024.
 - Saturday, February 22nd from 9:00 a.m. to NOON. CST for Beef, Dairy Beef and Market Heifers.
 - Saturday, April 26th from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. for Dairy Feeder Steers.
- Enter the fairgrounds at the Horse & Pony Arena off Zigler Road (Grandstand Drive).

- <u>ALL BEEF</u> animals (includes market steers and market heifers, dairy beef steers, dairy feeder steers, commercial heifers and registered heifers) must have a Radio Frequency Identification tag (840 RFID tags). Please note that it is imperative that any animal that loses the RFID Tag must have a new tag issued and linked with the corresponding hair sample.
- The Extension Office must be notified if any tag is lost or removed or the animal will not be allowed to show at the La Porte County or State Fair. A local county tag (yellow) will also be placed in market steers, market heifers, commercial heifers and dairy feeder steers.
- Animals led off the trailer will get a small gift.

Beef ID Worksheet

Enclosed is a Beef ID Worksheet for your record keeping and assist you while enrolling your animals in 4HOnline.

- This is **NOT** an animal enrollment form nor does it enroll your animals!
- You will need to bring it with you to the fairgrounds on ID Day.

Animal Enrollment Requirements

- Any youth that plans on exhibiting livestock this year at the county and/or State Fair will need to enroll their animals in the 4HOnline system.
- Animals will need to be enrolled online by the 4-H or family member by going to the following website address: <u>https://v2.4honline.com.</u>
- Dairy Steers & Dairy Feeder Steers must be 100% purebred.
- Siblings may show each other's animals. All the possible animals may be shared amongst siblings must be enrolled by a 4-H member of that family. All animals do not have to be enrolled under each sibling's name to be co-enrolled. **Registered heifers cannot be co-enrolled**.
- Animals can be enrolled in 4HOnline NOW! Deadline to enter all Animals is May 15th!

Fair Entry

- Fair Entry is the second step in being able to exhibit animals at the LaPorte County Fair.
- Declare the breed that you plan to show as on fair entry, these will be final and not changed at weigh in. For those that have registered animals as dual breeds, selection must be made on fair entry by June 23rd.
- Enter if you will be showing in the prospect show at this time on Fair Entry.
- If there are questions about breed guidelines visit the state fair website specific to your breed, which is what we will be using if there are any questions at the fair.
- Deadline is June 13, 2025 by 4:00 PM
- You will use the same email and password that is used with 4hOnline when visiting <u>https://fairentry.com</u>

YQCA or Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care (I4HQLC) Requirements

Each 4-H member who is participating in Beef or Dairy Feeder, Sheep, Goat, Swine, and Poultry projects will need to complete a quality assurance program.

• The Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program. These trainings will all be held in-person for the upcoming year and information will be posted when available.

• YQCA certification (online only) will be accepted. Please visit <u>yqcaprogram.org</u> to take the online training. Once completed it is your responsibility to send a copy of your certificate to the Extension Office so they have record of completion. Those certificates can be sent directly to <u>woznia11@purdue.edu</u>

County Fair

- LaPorte County Fair dates for 2025 are July 5th 12th.
- Check in will be on Friday, July 4th from 2:00 pm to 5:00 pm & Saturday, July 5th by 10:00 AM
- Check in for Prospects, dairy feeder steers and cow/calves is Sunday, July 6th by 9:00 AM
- 4-H Beef shows will be held on Sunday, July 6th and Tuesday, July 8th.
- The show order is as follows:
 - Sunday: Cow/calf, prospect calves, county bred, dairy feeders, feeder showmanship, and carcass.
 - Tuesday: Registered heifers, dairy steers, dairy showmanship, beef steers, and all levels of showmanship.

<u>State Fair</u>

<u>WHEN</u>

Friday, February 21st from 2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m. - By appointment only, call or text Jeff Smoker at 219-280-0524 by February 14, 2025. Saturday, February 22nd from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. CST time

WHERE

All tagging will be done at the LaPorte County Fairgrounds. Enter the fairgrounds at the Horse and Pony Arena off Zigler Road (Grandstand Drive).

All beef animals (includes market steers and market heifers, dairy beef steers, dairy feeder steers, commercial heifers and registered heifers) must have a Radio Frequency Identification tag (840 RFID tags).

<u>WHY</u>

All beef animals (includes market steers and market heifers, dairy beef steers, dairy feeder steers, commercial heifers and registered heifers) must have a Radio Frequency Identification tag (840 RFID tags).

It is crucial that any animal losing its RFID tag receives a new tag linked to the corresponding hair sample. The Extension Office must be informed of any lost or removed tags; otherwise, the animal cannot show at the La Porte County or Indiana State Fair. Additionally, a local county tag (yellow) will be placed on market steers, market heifers, commercial heifers, and dairy feeder steers.
