Dear 4-H Sheep and Committee Members,

**IMPORTANT PROJECT INFORMATION:**

- **All members must be enrolled in 4HOnline.**
- All market lambs must be born after January 1 and be in the member's care by May 1.
- All sheep must be entered into 4HOnline before May 15<sup>th</sup>. *It is the responsibility of the 4-H member* and or family to enroll their animals online. Instructions are be found at: <https://extension.purdue.edu/4-H/docs/projects/animal-identification/animal-id-instructions.pdf>
- 4-H members may have up to 10 market lambs enrolled, but may show only 5 animals at the fair. They must weigh at least 70 lbs. at fair time. Only 3 may be sold in the auction.
- 4-H members may enroll 2 breeding animals per class.
- 4-H Market Lambs, commercial (Non-registered) and registered breeding stock must be tagged on May 3<sup>rd</sup>
- If any of your sheep losses an ear tag, contact Jake Salisbury or Don Stoner.

- **Saturday, May 2, 2026 from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.**
  - I.D. Days are at the Draft Horse Barn. Animals with sore mouth should arrive toward the end of the times listed. Please inform the volunteers tagging your animals that day that your sheep are infected because sore mouth can be contracted by humans.

- The 4-H Sheep Committee will be ear tagging all market lambs. A charge of \$6.00 per lamb will pay for tags and supplies.
- Enter the fairgrounds off of Ziegler Road at Grandstand Drive and proceed west to the Draft Horse Barn. Trucks and trailers will enter the west end of the Draft Horse Barn and exit on the east end of the Draft Horse Barn after animals are identified.
- **Sunday, June 30th at 6:00 p.m. | LaPorte County Fairgrounds | Sheep Barn**
  - Fair pen set up pens, tour of the new show arena & fair week expectations.
  - Shearing Workshop

#### **ANIMAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- **Market lambs**
  - County Fair: A 5-digit county tag will be used.
  - State Fair: An 840 RFID tag, 5-digit county tag and DNA hair sample.
- **Commercial ewes**
  - State Fair: An 840 RFID tag, and 5-digit county tag or an official scrapies tag and DNA hair sample.
- **Registered ewes**
  - State Fair: An 840 RFID tag and ID that matches registration papers and a DNA hair sample.

#### **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- **Rule Changes**

- **Sheep Id Worksheet**  
Enclosed is a Sheep ID Worksheet for your record keeping and assisting you while enrolling your animals in 4HOnline. This is **NOT** an animal enrollment form and does not count as enrolling your animal online. You must still ID your animals through 4-H Online. The worksheet is simply to assist you with inputting the information into the computer. You do not need to turn in the worksheet, nor do you need to bring it with you to the fairgrounds on ID Day unless you want to fill it out for your records.

#### **INDIANA 4-H QUALITY LIVESTOCK OR YQCA REQUIREMENTS**

Each 4-H member who is participating in Beef or Dairy Feeder, Sheep, Goat, Swine, and Poultry projects will need to complete a quality assurance program by June 12th.

- 1) The Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program. These trainings will all be held in-person for the upcoming year and registration is open in 4HOnline, under Events, look for LaPorte County – Indiana 4-H Livestock Quality Care.
- 2) YQCA certification (online only) will be accepted. Please visit [yqcaprogram.org](https://yqcaprogram.org) to take the online training. Once completed it is your responsibility to send a copy of your certificate to the Extension Office so they have record of completion. #### **FAIR ENTRY**

FairEntry is the second step in being able to exhibit animals at the LaPorte County Fair. All 4-H members will need to enter the animals that they intend to bring to the fair exhibition in Fair Entry by June 12, 2026. You will use the same email and password that is used with 4HOnline when visiting <https://faireentry.com>

#### **STATE FAIR**

You may enroll 30 total sheep. For State Fair all market lambs and breeding ewes (including registered ewes) must be tagged. State Fair entry information may be found at: <https://www.indianastatefair.com/p/state-fair/competitions--contests/4-h-competitions-entry-information>

*It is your responsibility* to bring your animals to the Fairgrounds for tagging on either Friday, May 1<sup>st</sup> or Saturday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>. No other days will be scheduled! *The committee will not go to an individual's home to tag after the deadline.*  
Please inform any new members about this date.

4-H members will need to make arrangements with someone else to have their animals taken to the fairgrounds on these dates if they are unable to attend.
