This is a one-time scholarship worth \$2,000. This scholarship is open to any graduating senior that is currently enrolled in LaPorte County 4-H. Each applicant must qualify under the following rules:

1. Applicant must have been enrolled in 4-H for at least four (4) previous years in LaPorte County.
2. Individual must intend to pursue a degree at a university, college or trade school.
3. Applicant must be maintaining at least a “C” average and supply a transcript along with this application.
4. Applications must be thoroughly completed with submission. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
5. Application must be typed. No handwritten responses will be eligible for consideration.
6. Completed application must be delivered inside the Extension Office no later than 3:59pm on Friday, May 29th.
