NEW THIS YEAR:

We are requesting a \$20 cash stall fee, which should be submitted to us no later than June 1st. At the end of the fair, if you have cleaned out your stall and it has been inspected, you will receive \$10 back. The remaining funds will be allocated to club expenses for future needs or to assist with paying the judges during the fair.
