- 4. Recipient must submit a written report concerning their **accomplishments from using grant funds by July 1 of the year following** the awarding of the grant. The report is to be submitted to the La Porte County Extension Office.
- 5. Members may receive the grant more than one time as a 4-H swine member, but only once in 4 years. They may re-apply for the grant the 5<sup>th</sup> year after receiving a grant.

The grant and plaque will be awarded during the Swine Auction at the La Porte County Fair.
