SCHOOL PROGRAMMING

We have had a great time visiting schools throughout the county and continue to grow our school programming efforts. We have reached well over 1000 youth through our school-based educational opportunities this year.

- South Central Elementary- 4-H information session and STEM lessons with all 3rd grade students
- Westville Elementary- 4-H information session to all 3rd and 4th grade students
- Lake Hills Elementary- Soccer for Success programming with all 4th and 5th grade students and Invention Convention with 30 kids in K-6
- Rolling Prairie Elementary- STEM and 4-H information session with all Kindergarteners
- New Prairie High School- Resume writing workshop with 40 high school students
- Career Days at Westville High School, New Prairie High School, and LaPorte High School
- Ag Days with 4th Grade youth from across the county, reaching 791 Youth
- Field Days in partnership with LP County Soil and Water with 5th Grade Youth from across the county
- Indian Trail Elementary- Supported Drone Program led by Jesi, our ANR educator, and a STEM activity with all 4th grade students

PINNEY PURDUE DIAGNOSTIC TRAINING

Mark your calendar for June 18 and join us at the Pinney Purdue Agricultural Center in Wanatah, IN for a hands-on Diagnostic Training Day!

Registration begins at 9:00 AM, and attendees will have the opportunity to earn pesticide credits across multiple categories, including PARP.

Spend the day gaining valuable insights into earlyseason crop development and the impact of insect pests, while also exploring the latest weather and climate tools to support your farm management decisions. It's an educational event you won't want to miss!

PURDUE ON THE FARM

This growing season, LaPorte County is proud to partner with Purdue on the Farm—a cutting-edge program bringing real-time, farm-specific insights directly to local producers. Through this initiative, partnering farmers will receive real-time reports that track disease emergence, helping to pinpoint the most effective times for treatment and application. In addition, UAV (drone) technology will be used throughout the season to capture thermal imagery, offering a powerful new perspective on crop health and field conditions.

MASTER GARDENER BASIC TRAINING

This late winter and spring, we've been hard at work with the 14-week Master Gardener Basic Training—and we're excited to share some great news!

A total of 22 participants from Porter and LaPorte Counties have successfully completed the course, with 4 new Master Gardeners joining us right here in LaPorte County.

GRACE LEARNING CENTER - MONTHLY HEALTH LESSONS |

A monthly partnership with Grace Learning Center has been established to provide interactive health education lessons focused on chronic disease prevention, healthy eating, and wellness. These sessions are designed to serve individuals and families facing economic challenges and have shown steady participation through ongoing community engagement.

BE HEART SMART – BEGINNING JUNE AT THE ACTIVITY CENTER FOR OLDER ADULTS |

The Be Heart Smart program will be implemented in June at the Activity Center for Older Adults, in collaboration with LaPorte City Parks.

This four-week heart health education series is tailored for older adults and includes:

- Education on heart disease risk factors
- Strategies for managing blood pressure and cholesterol
- Recognition of heart attack and stroke symptoms
- Guidance on adopting simple, heart-healthy lifestyle habits

The program emphasizes goal setting, open discussion, and long-term behavior change.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND ENGAGEMENT |

This quarter's work also focused on expanding outreach efforts to underserved populations, particularly older adults and low-income residents. Programming remains centered on accessible, research-based health education that reflects community needs and promotes long-term well-being.
