4-H CLUB

VARIABLE RATE OF FEE REMISSION – Freshman in Purdue Ag or HHS School majoring in Ag or Consumer and Family Sciences. Must have a Financial Aid Form on file in the Financial Aids Office; 4-H white achievement cards must accompany application from Extension Office. **APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 25th.**

Indiana 4-H Accomplishment Scholarships

\$500 – Available for any schooling beyond high school studies or training and submit complete 4-H resume. **APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 25th.**

4-H Senior Scholarship

\$500 – Available for any schooling beyond high school. The recipient needs to be enrolled in any post high school study or training and have filled out the 4-H Foundation Scholarship Application. It is paid for by Junior Leaders and 4-H Inc. Montgomery County is guaranteed two recipients. **APPLICATION DEADLINE IS JANUARY 25.**

Montgomery County Beef Scholarship

Montgomery County Beef Association will award a \$500 scholarship for any 4-Her continuing their education. They must exhibit a beef animal at the County Fair or State Fair each of the 10 years they are in 4-H.
