

Northern Lights in Indiana??- YES!

Mike and I had heard there was a possible chance of seeing the Northern Lights last night in Indiana. People were saying you could see them through your camera on your phone. The best viewing time was between 10:00pm—2:00am. The reason this is happening:

"Space weather forecasters at NOAA's Space Weather Prediction Center (SWPC) issued a rare (G4) severe geomagnetic storm warning beginning Thursday, Oct. 10 and stretching into Friday, Oct. 11. The agency is monitoring solar conditions after a strong X -class flare pushed out a coronal mass ejection from the center of the sun Wednesday."-John Tufts-Indy Star

Mike and I drove down to Henderson Ford Road so it would be dark, we took some pictures, drove home and couldn't believe what it looked like right over our house! We didn't need to drive out of our driveway, we should have just looked up before leaving hahaha!

If you would like to try to see them tonight there might still be a chance. It will be late and dark 10pm-2am, take your phone outside in your yard, point your phone camera up into the sky and look around. (sounds funny because they are called Northern Lights you should just have to point north, but we had to do a little searching to find the right spot) If you see a little pink, snap a picture and take a look. Hopefully you will see the beautiful Northern Lights in your photo:)
