Scholarship Application Form

ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to students pursuing a two- or four-year degree in agri-business or a related field, including turf or turf management. Eligible applicants include graduating high school seniors, as well as college freshmen, sophomores, and juniors enrolled in advanced education courses. Applicants must reside within the Ag Plus trade area. Applications must be signed by a school official or guidance counselor and postmarked by February 28, 2026.

DESCRIPTION: Four (4) scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded to eligible applicants. Selections will be based on scholastic achievement, demonstrated leadership, and the applicant's potential to contribute to the future of agriculture.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. A completed application form.
2. High school or college grade transcript.
3. Three reference letters. These can either be included with the application or mailed separately (refer to the attached *Ag Plus Scholarship Reference* document for details).
4. Signature of a school official or guidance counselor verifying current student status (see the *School Signature* page).

Use the *Scholarship Application Checklist* to ensure all materials are completed and included.

- On a separate sheet of paper, please address the following about the candidate:
 - Leadership abilities
 - Worthiness of the scholarship
 - Potential to positively impact agriculture
 - Citizenship
 - Attitude
 - Involvement in organizations
 - Ensure the reference letter is **dated** and **signed**. Letters missing these elements will lose points.
